FEES

The Fairfield Foundation charges a \$175/week fee for each intern. Please include a check made payable to the Fairfield Foundation at the time you submit the internship application. The fee helps cover the costs of equipment, transportation, logistics, and administrative tasks related to the internship. Scholarships are available to cover these fees based on financial need and more information is available upon request. **PLEASE NOTE:** the fees *do not* cover personal expenses, such as food, personal items, or housing (see below). The intern will be expected to cover these costs on their own. The fee is fully refundable if the internship is cancelled more than two weeks prior to commencing.

HOUSING

Housing with host families at low or no cost is available on a first-come, first-served basis and is limited. Host families will often provide some meals and other needs, but interns should be prepared to cover their own personal expenses. Personal transportation is encouraged, but not required.
